

Shaping South Gippsland – Community Vision 2040

South Gippsland Shire Council is inviting community members to shape the future of South Gippsland by developing the Community Vision for 2040.

The vision is a chance for the community to outline what is important to them for the future of the region while exploring potential challenges and opportunities that could emerge. Participants can utilise a range of opportunities this year to share their views including:

- Completing an online survey open in December
- Registering for the independent community panel by 12 December
- Visiting a community pop-up
 - o Saturday 11 December 8.00am to 10.00am Coal Creek Market, Korumburra
 - o Sunday 12 December 10.00am to 12.00pm Kongwak Market

Further community pop-ups and online discussions in early 2022 will be promoted once dates are confirmed.

The Community Vision 2040 will set the foundation for the Council Plan 2022-2025 and will ensure actions undertaken by Council are guided by community aspirations now and into the future.

The community panel recruitment is being managed by Deliberately Engaging to ensure a thorough process is achieved. Twenty-five panel members will be randomly selected independently by Deliberately Engaging to meet demographic goals for balanced membership.
