Green Waste Amnesty

To assist residents to remove potential fire hazards on their properties, Council is providing a Green Waste Amnesty until 31 December 2021.

Residents can dispose of their green waste for free at any of Council's transfer stations during this period.

The following species are not included in the amnesty: Blackberry, Ragwort, Broom, Mirror Bush, Kikuyu Grass, Hawthorn, Cape Weed, Gorse, Blue Butterfly Bush, Pampas Grass, Palm fronds, Cordylines, Yuccas and related species. If you are receiving a support payment and need help paying, the Victorian Government is providing one-off payments of \$250 to eligible households to help with their energy costs.

You can apply if you receive a:

- Centrelink pension concession
- Department of Veteran Affairs pension concession
- Jobseeker
- Youth Allowance, Abstudy or Austudy.

- Monday 20 December between 10.00am and 4.00pm at Baromi Centre, Mirboo North.
- Tuesday 21 December between 11.00am and 4.00pm at Leongatha RSL.

Make sure you bring along your concession card and recent energy bill.
