

Register Now for the Community Vision Forum

In South Gippsland, the work continues to create our Community Vision 2040.

The project gives our community the opportunity to inform what South Gippsland will look like in 2040, including the potential challenges and opportunities that may be faced then and along the way.

So far, the Community Vision work has included:

- An online survey that closed on 11 January.
- Community pop-ups across South Gippsland.
- A community panel registration that saw 162 South Gippslanders state their intentions to be part of the panel. The successful registrants have been contacted ready for their first meeting on 5 February.

Now the focus shifts to an online forum, which is set to be held on 2 February at 6.00pm. This forum will be via Zoom and also a text-based discussion platform created by the consultants on this project, Deliberately Engaging. The platform is designed to be engaging for all participants, but support will be at hand if required.
