

## Street Cleaning and Permit Reductions

South Gippsland Shire Council is undertaking a number of initiatives to assist local businesses and communities to recover from the impacts of COVID-19. Developed with funding support from the Victorian Government's Outdoor Activation Fund, the activities aim to support industries that were impacted by COVID restrictions and assist businesses to operate in a COVIDSafe outdoor setting.

The first activity to be delivered as part of the program is food registration discounts for 360 businesses. The discounts are a small, but effective, way to help businesses to reduce their operating costs. The total value of the food registration subsidies is approximately \$47,000. The cost of footpath trading permits for 2022/23 will also be reduced as part of the assistance program.

Another project already underway is the revitalisation of main street areas in Mirboo North, Korumburra and Foster. Using high-pressure cleaning equipment, a contractor has been busy cleaning footpaths and street furniture in the three towns, making them more inviting to use and complementing outdoor dining areas.

More activities are planned and will be delivered progressively over the next few months.
