Key Projects for 2022/23



Expanding our Gravel Roads Resheeting Program to include up to an additional 20km of road, taking our total up to a maximum of 120km.



Reviewing unfunded projects from the Paths and Trails Strategy to connect small towns experiencing population growth.



Advocating for vastly improved digital connectivity (mobile and internet).



Leveraging Council's investment in the Great Southern Rail Trail to increase visitation to our Shire.



Developing a Reconciliation Action Plan.



Commencing the investigation and feasibility for the renewal of the Korumburra Pool.



Commencing the development of a new Waste Management Plan which will include investigating the delivery of a 'Food Organics Green Organics' service.



Undertaking a complete review of Council's Planning Scheme.

Council is also considering and proposing changes to some Fees and Charges, including:

- Adding a casual user fee for Splash Stadium of \$4.50.
- Halving the fees for Hall Hire for community use.
