

Clause 46 of the South Gippsland Shire Council's General Local Law states:

46. Keeping animals

- (1) An owner or occupier of a property must not, without a permit, keep or allow to be kept any more in number for each kind of animal than as set out in the following table:

<i>Type of animal</i>	<i>Maximum number of animals allowed in residential, mixed use, commercial, township & industrial zones as defined in the relevant planning scheme</i>	<i>Maximum number of animals allowed in rural conservation & rural living zones as defined in the relevant planning scheme</i>
Dogs	2	2
Cats	2	2

- (2) Subclause (1) does not apply where a planning permit has been obtained for land used for the purposes of an animal shelter, animal boarding, animal breeding or animal keeping.
