

Proposed Clarence Street, Loch Road Discontinuance

At today's Council meeting, Councillors voted to start the process to discontinue part of a lane way at the rear of 8 Clarence Street, Loch.

This section of road forms part of a road reserve that is currently vacant and unused. It also does not appear on Council's Public Road Register. A previous section was sold to the owners of 10 Clarence Street, Loch in 2021.

As part of the process, the community will have a chance to make a submission on the discontinuance. Submissions must be received no later than 5.00pm Wednesday 26 October 2022 and be addressed to the Chief Executive Officer. Anyone who makes a submission is entitled to be heard in support of the submission. If you or a representative wishes to be heard in support of the submission, you must state this in your submission.
