

Foster Locals Encouraged to Provide Feedback on their Town's Future

At yesterday's meeting, Council endorsed going out for public comment on the Foster Structure Plan Discussion Paper.

The Discussion Paper has been designed to give the community information about the current state of play and some prompting questions for the future of Foster.

During the engagement period, the community are encouraged to come along to one of the following drop-in sessions:

- Friday 25 November – 9.00am to 12.00pm in the Foster Main Street at the covered laneway.
- Sunday 11 December – 9.00am to 11.00am at the Prom Produce and Craft Market (Foster Showgrounds).

Once feedback closes on Friday 23 December 2022, Council will work to develop a Draft Structure Plan that will be released for final public comment in 2023.
