Animal Registrations

Our four-legged companions are important family members so it's essential that we keep them safe and secure. Owning an animal in South Gippsland requires registration with Council which helps ensure they can be returned to you if they become lost. Your animal registration fees also help to provide important pet-related services within South Gippsland, such as animal control and community education about responsible pet ownership.

If you own a dog or cat, it's important that you:

Register each dog or cat you own

- Ensure each dog or cat you own is microchipped
- Make sure that each dog or cat wears a valid Council registration tag

- Keep your dog confined to your property
- Make sure your dog doesn't bark persistently
- Stop your dog or cat from straying onto another person's property if that person objects
- Prevent your dog from chasing or attacking people or animals

Responsible pet ownership is important for our fur family and our community.

Renewal registrations must be paid by the April 10 each year. New dog and cat registrations can be made anytime throughout the year.
