Advocacy Meetings

It is important for local government to work with other levels of government to build relationships and generate support for our local advocacy priorities.

The past week, we have had opportunities to connect with our Federal and State Government colleagues on a number of topics.

Tom McIntosh, the State Member for Eastern Victoria, came to Mirboo North on Tuesday to visit the Mirboo North Kindergarten. This is on the back of Council receiving \$150,000 from the Victorian Government to undertake pre-construction planning for the future development of a new Early Learning Centre in the town.

Also on Tuesday, Mayor Nathan Hersey and our Chief Executive Officer Kerryn Ellis, along with other representatives from One Gippsland, went to Canberra to continue to advocate for our region. While in Canberra, the delegation met with five MPs and a number of senior ministerial advisors to discuss key topics such as the new energy transition, roads and digital connectivity.

Councillors received a briefing from Member for Gippsland South, Danny O'Brien MP on Wednesday. During the briefing, they spoke about his recent trip to overseas offshore wind farms and the energy transition to renewables.

These opportunities are extremely important as they help to ensure South Gippsland is considered in key decisions. We are important and deserve to be heard.
