



Toora Jetty Upgrade to Commence

The Toora jetty and boat ramp will be closed from Monday 20 February to prepare the site for the installation of a new jetty.

Replacement of the jetty is expected to take up to two weeks.

The new jetty will be pontoon style, similar to the current jetty.

The replacement follows an inspection of the existing jetty by a structural engineer, which identified a number of issues. It was determined that a full replacement would be the most appropriate treatment.

South Gippsland Shire Council contributed \$40,000 towards the replacement, with \$210,000 funded by Better Boating Victoria.
