



MAV Board position for Mayor Hersey

South Gippsland Shire Council Mayor, Cr Nathan Hersey has been elected to the Municipal Association of Victoria (MAV) Board representing the Gippsland region.

The MAV is the legislated peak body for Victoria's 79 local councils and the voice of local government in Victoria. Its role is to represent and advocate local government interests, build the capacity of councils and provide policy and strategic advice.
