

Celebrating our 2022/23 Round 2 Community Grants Recipients

It was a fantastic night of celebration on Wednesday 19 July as we recognised the successful recipients of the second round of the 2022/23 Community Grants Program.

During the night, 25 applicants received funding for their projects with a total of \$130,000 allocated.

The Community Grants Program aims to support community initiatives, projects and events. It is open to not-for-profit, community and volunteer organisations who may have a project or initiative that fits under the following categories:

- Minor Projects and Equipment (up to \$5,000).
- Major Projects and Equipment (up to \$10,000).
- Planning and Development Reports (up to \$10,000).
- Festivals and Events (up to \$10,000).

Round One of the 2023/24 Community Grants Program is open now and closes 31 August. If you need assistance with your application, a number of drop-in sessions are available – or you can contact Sophie Bolding on 5662 9200.
