

Korumburra Mural Expressions of Interest – Now Open

South Gippsland Shire Council is seeking a suitable qualified artist or artists, to paint a mural on the wall that leads to the railway underpass in Korumburra. The site connects the town with the railway precinct and Great Southern Rail Trail and receives high amounts of pedestrian and cycling traffic.

The mural will be located on the external wall of 42 Commercial Street which has a total wall space of 30 metres wide by 4.6 metres high, however it is not expected that the entire surface will be covered. The theme of the mural is *local community, landscape, flora and fauna*.

Interest in the project is via Expression of Interest (EOI). After the EOI closes, three shortlisted artists will be invited to develop a preliminary concept design that the community can vote on. The artist that receives the most votes will then complete a detailed design which they will paint on the mural site in December.
