Korumburra Railway Precinct Mural

The Korumburra Railway Precinct features a heritage listed railway station, and a nearby underpass.

Since closure of the railway line in 1993, the Precinct has been vacant and now is being transformed into a space for all to enjoy. As part of the revitalisation of the Korumburra Railway Precinct, Council put a call out for qualified artists or artist collectives to design an immersive, creative and fun mural that will go on the external wall of 42 Commercial Street.

The Korumburra mural project has been funded through an external grant that Council successfully received.

Artists were required to create their initial concepts based on the theme of local community, landscape, flora and fauna, which was developed through consultation with students from Korumburra Secondary College.

To capture interested artists, an Expression of Interest was released a few months ago, resulting in 18 impressive submissions in September. This was then narrowed down to just three by representatives from South Gippsland Arts Advisory Committee, Korumburra Secondary

College and Council's Arts Development Officer

The shortlisted artists are:

- Matt Ling.
- Magic Lantern Studio.
- Melanie Caple.

It was expected that the concept designs would be a contemporary take on the theme, rather than recreate the type of historical murals previously seen across South Gippsland.

We are now looking to you, our community, to make the final decision on which artist/artist's will be given the opportunity to create an innovative mural transform this space.
