About: The ArtCubes

The ArtCubes support and enable creative development and community vibrancy in our small-towns region, providing low-risk, low-cost, high-impact spaces for cultural projects. They are designed to encourage creative experimentation and expression. As the spaces are intimate, they offer unusual creative possibilities, for artists, performers or community members, as stand alone venues, or in the context of a larger event or festival.

The Cubes are lined with ply and feature two opening container doors, two windows, solar panels, as well as internal gallery lighting and a wash of external lights. Each ArtCube is completely self-sufficient, enabling them to be located in remote and unexpected locations, as well as in town centres, travelling as a bunch of three, or as single units.

The ArtCubes are designed to be activated with creativity – this might include sculpture or paintings, installations, performances or even a quirky bar or events centre. Installed with artworks, they can be left with the door closed, inviting curious visitors to see what is inside the Cube through the windows. They can also be opened up wide (with two doors or one), inviting participation and engagement within the space.
