

Hazel Park Road Update

Following torrential rain on Boxing Day two Council roads in the Toora vicinity – Silcocks Hill Road and Hazel Park Road – sustained significant damage.

Silcocks Hill Road was closed due to a landslip that caused mud and debris to fall across both sides of the road. Council was able to clear and reopen this road on Boxing Day, however additional remedial works will be required. Hazel Park Road was also impacted, with a large hole opening in the middle of the road, requiring the road closure.

Council's initial investigations on Hazel Park Road indicate culvert replacement and road restoration will be required. This is expected to take a number of weeks to complete due to the magnitude of the impact.
