Access and Inclusion Advisory Committee

South Gippsland Shire Council is seeking expressions of interest from our community to be a part of the South Gippsland Access and Inclusion Advisory Committee.

The new Committee will provide input on access and inclusion issues, and feedback that will inform the development of an Access and Inclusion Plan for South Gippsland. The plan is aimed at ensuring everyone in our community has equal access to public spaces, goods, services and facilities.

The committee will be made up of 15 members – nine community representatives and five organisational members (organisations that work with people who experience disability, barriers to inclusion due to their gender identity, ethnicity, sexual orientation etc.).

Interested community members should have experience living with a disability or caring for someone with a disability or lived experience of other barriers to inclusion.

Our goal is to have systems in place to make sure everyone in our Shire can participate in both public and professional life meaning everyone has the resources and opportunities they need to be a part of the things they want to be a part of.

Recovery support is available for people impacted by the 13 February Victorian storms. Understanding the support available can be challenging, particularly for people who might not be used to asking for help. If you were severely impacted by the storm, you may be eligible for a recovery support worker. They can work with you over time to find and access the support you need.

STORM-RELATED GREEN WASTE AMNESTY

Council's storm-related Green Waste Amnesty will finish on 2 April at all transfer stations aside from Mirboo North. Storm-related green waste will still be accepted at Mirboo North Transfer Station until 30 April.

The Amnesty was put in place to assist residents with clean-up efforts after the February storm event. The end date has been bought forward at other Transfer Stations as demand for storm-related green waste disposal has abated in those areas.
