



Funding Announcement for Road Safety Investigation in Loch

South Gippsland Shire Council received confirmation that the State Government will fund a traffic study along Victoria Road in Loch.

South Gippsland Shire Council was one of 40 Victorian councils who received funding under the Transport Accident Commission's Local Government Grant Program. It will see \$30,000 go towards a local traffic assessment, which will explore options to ensure that Victoria Road including the Loch Primary School and tourist precinct is safe for all.

"We are very pleased to have received funding to assess the level of traffic safety along Victoria Road in Loch. The study will help us understand what areas of the road can be improved and how the roads use has changed over time.
