

Corner Inlet Motorcycle Club Lease Open for Feedback

The proposed lease of 2746 Meeniyen Promontory Road, Yanakie to the Corner Inlet Motorcycle Club is now open for community consultation, as part of Council's budget feedback process.

The Corner Inlet Motorcycle Club first leased this land in December 2004 and in May 2015, the lease was renewed for ten years. As this period is drawing to an end (May 2025) the Club is seeking to extend the lease.

Council is proposing to lease the 14.9 hectare site, zoned Public Park and Recreation, to the Corner Inlet Motorcycle Club for five years as of 1 July 2025 with an option for a further term lease of five years. It is proposed it will be for a community rental of \$104 plus GST per year for the specific purpose and use of the land to continue as a motorcycle track and motorcycle club.

The Corner Inlet Motorcycle Club has developed a 1.6-kilometre track featuring an array of jumps, berms and straights. The Club prides itself on being a family friendly community group that caters to all ages and riding abilities.

Feedback on the proposed lease extension closes on Wednesday 7 May 2025.
