

Korumburra Tennis Club Pavillion Receives One Million in Funding

South Gippsland Shire Council is pleased to welcome the Victorian Government's announcement of a \$1 million contribution toward the Korumburra Tennis Club Pavilion Redevelopment Project.

This funding—delivered through the Regional Community Sports Infrastructure Fund—will be combined with \$475,000 from Council and \$25,000 from the Tennis Club to deliver on a new clubhouse to help boost participation across the region.

Korumburra Tennis Club maintains a strong tennis culture – with a diverse range of players from school aged children to seniors and nearly equal gender distribution.

The modern new tennis pavilion provides female friendly facilities whilst addressing the accessibility challenges of the site, with the provision of all abilities access for both players and spectators.
