Council's Maternal and Child Health nurses are registered nurses and midwives, with additional qualifications in child and family health.

Our service can help with:

- Immunisations
- Child safety and illness
- Family wellbeing

- Health checks
- Referrals to allied health services

There are multiple Maternal and Child Health Centres located across the Shire.

The Maternal and Child Health team also provide a Sleep and Settling Program, offering telephone and limited face-to-face consultations with evidence-based approaches to support sleep and settling for your child.
