

Coal Creek welcomes Dogs!

Visitors to Coal Creek Community Park and Museum are now welcome to bring their four-legged friends. This change means more people can make the most of the Park's natural beauty while strolling alongside their canine companions.

New infrastructure has been installed to support the change, including water bowls and waste facilities.

Conditions have been put in place to protect the heritage buildings and the Park's wildlife; dogs must be kept on a short leash, are not allowed inside the buildings, and owners must always supervise them. Visitors are welcome to walk their dogs into the Park via the main building but are not permitted to enter the gallery spaces with them.
