Green Waste Amnesty

Dispose of green waste for free at any Council transfer station until 31 December.

The annual Green Waste Amnesty is an ideal time to get prepared for the fire-season by clearing your gutters and removing dry leaves, branches and any other potential fire hazards from around your property.

Be mindful that some plants aren't accepted during the amnesty because they lower the quality of the mulch that is produced. These species include Agapanthus, Blackberry, Ragwort, Broom, Mirror Bush, Kikuyu Grass, Hawthorn, Cape Weed, Gorse, Blue Butterfly Bush, Bamboo and Pampas Grass.

Plants that are difficult to mulch properly are also not included in

the amnesty. These species include palm fronds, Yuccas, Cordylines and other related species. If any of these plants are taken to a transfer station, they must be disposed of as general waste with applicable disposal fees applying.

Alternatively, they can be disposed of through the kerbside green waste collection service, as this material is subjected to a different composting process.

So, now that the weather is warming up, why not tidy up your yard and dispose of any green waste for free.
