

General Local Law Permits Application



This permit application relates to the following permit types, under Council's *General Local Law 2024*. **Please include the \$35.00 fee when submitting this application.**

Use of roads and municipal places

Clause 10 – Damaging or defacing a municipal place

This is a permit to undertake an activity that will damage or deface Council property.

This is a permit to place something on Council land that will cause a physical or visual obstruction.

Clause 20 – Storage of vehicles on roads

This is a permit to park a long or heavy vehicle on a Council road.

Clause 24 – Riding horses in a municipal place

This is a permit to ride a horse in an otherwise prohibited Council area.

Alcohol and smoking

Clause 25 – Possession and consumption of alcohol

This is a permit to possess and consume alcohol in an otherwise prohibited Council area.

Trading activities

Clause 27 – Roadside performing

This is a permit to perform/busk on Council land (including footpaths).

For a permit for roadside trading under the same clause, please see separate application form.

Clause 31 – Collections

This is a permit to solicit, collect or distribute on roads, Council land or door to door.

■ **Clause 37 – Heavy and long vehicles on private property**

This is a permit to keep a heavy or long vehicle on private property.

■ **Clause 38 – Use of recreational vehicles on private property**

This is a permit to use a motorcycle or recreational vehicle on private property that is less than two hectares.

■ **Clause 48 – Restrictions on burning in the open air – municipal places**

This is a permit to light a fire on Council land.
