The Mary Rogers Award celebrates notable civic leadership by women councillors in Victoria.

Councillor Gilligan earned her nomination for championing the protection of South Gippsland's precious coastline, successfully driving three motions through the Municipal Association of Victoria to urge the Victorian Government to action. Her advocacy has also helped secure \$80,000 to explore an innovative solution to coastal storm surges using the Venus Bay saltmarsh.

While she didn't take home the award this time, being nominated is a fantastic achievement.

FREE MEASLES, MUMPS AND RUBELLA (MMR) VACCINATIONS

Council's Immunisation Service is providing free MMR Vaccines to anyone who may not have received two doses.

Measles is a highly infectious disease that can cause serious illness and two doses of MMR vaccine are required for protection.

You are at risk of measles if:

- You were born between 1966 to 1992.
- · You were born overseas.
- You are travelling overseas infants as young as six months old can have the vaccine prior to travel.

If you born after 1966 and are unsure if you have had a second dose, get vaccinated. To book in for a session or for more information, visit:
