Free Measles Vaccine Available



Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) vaccinations are available at Council immunisation sessions. The vaccine is recommended for anyone born during or after 1966 who does not have documented evidence of receiving two doses.

Measles is a highly infectious disease that can cause serious illness. There have been three cases in Gippsland in recent weeks.

No Medicare card is required to receive a free vaccine.
