



New Asset Committee Established for the Meeniyah Community Hub

At South Gippsland Shire Council's February 2026 Council Meeting, the establishment of a Community Asset Committee for the Meeniyah Community Hub was endorsed.

The Committee will manage the facility on behalf of Council and coordinate bookings, negotiate building use (including seasonal agreements), and set user fees.

To support the Committee as it becomes established, Council will provide \$6,000 in seed funding to cover expenses in year one while the Committee gets up-and-running. In subsequent years, fees and charges collected through the use of the facility will contribute to ongoing costs.

Council will contact those who have expressed interest in joining the Community Asset Committee to provide further information about the roles and responsibilities involved.
