All of our Maternal and Child Health nurses are registered nurses and midwives, with additional qualifications in child and family health. There are six MCH Centres located across South Gippsland.

Our friendly and qualified staff can provide support across a range of areas, including:

- Recovery after birth.
- Sleep and settling.

- Feeding.
- Growth and development.
- Immunisation information.
- Child safety and illness.
- Family wellbeing.
- Developmental health checks, and early intervention when needed.
