Seeking Feedback on Flood Overlay Planning Scheme Amendment

Council is seeking informed community feedback on a Draft Planning Scheme Amendment relating to flood studies.

The amendment proposes to update flood mapping, including the introduction of a Floodway Overlay and Land Subject to Inundation Overlay across a number of areas in Foster, Hedley, Kongwak, Welshpool, the Tarwin River catchment and along South Gippsland's coast.

The purpose of this proposed amendment is to improve flood resilience and preparedness across the region. The overlays do not prevent development, but may require a planning permit for buildings and works so flood risk can be properly considered. This helps reduce future flood damage and minimise impacts on surrounding land.

We understand that Planning Scheme Amendments are not always straight

forward, so to help our community better understand what's involved within this amendment, we've put together a range of resources, including:

- An interactive map where you can type in your address and see if there are any mapping changes to flood overlays on your property.
- A copy of all Draft Amendment documents.
- Frequently Asked Questions.
- Details of community information drop-in sessions.
- Information about making a submission.
- Link to Council's submission portal.
