How to Prepare for the First 72 Hours of an Emergency

Council is hosting a series of community workshops to help residents prepare to stay safe during the initial hours of an emergency.

Storms, power outages and floods can severely disrupt daily life. Emergency services, power companies and relief agencies often experience extremely high demand during these events. While help will arrive as soon as possible, it may take time for support to reach every community. That's why it is important to be prepared to look after yourself, your family, and your pets for the first 72 hours following an emergency.

Come along to a practical community session and learn how to:

- Create a simple emergency plan.
- Find out what supplies may be helpful at home.

- Learn where to get emergency information and support.
- Connect with local people and services.

South Gippsland is a beautiful, and sometimes wild, place. We've had our share of storms and unexpected events that remind us just how quickly conditions can change. Taking some time to prepare for an emergency can make those first few hours a little more manageable.

Community workshops will take place in Korumburra, Venus Bay, Tarwin Lower, Sandy Point, Leongatha, Foster and Mirboo North in coming months.

Flu season is well and truly upon us! In addition to all regular vaccines, the 2026 Influenza vaccine is now available at Council's immunisation sessions. Getting vaccinated is not only the best way to protect yourself, it's also essential for protecting our community's most vulnerable from illness.

Measles cases are also on the rise - the Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR vaccine) is recommended for anyone born after 1966 who hasn't already had two doses. Plus, it's free!
