Accepted materials

Recyclables (free of charge)

Paper/cardboard, glass bottles and jars, plastic bottles and containers (rigid plastic types 1–7), steel, whitegoods, car batteries and used motor oil.

Other wastes (fees apply)

Domestic garbage, furniture, car bodies, tyres, concrete, bricks, clean fill, commercial wastes, domestic asbestos (landfill only, conditions apply), green waste, gas bottles and electronic waste.

Materials NOT accepted

Paint, chemicals and liquid waste.

Household quantities of these items may be taken to Detox Your Home collection days.

Silage plastic recycling program

Council participates in the Plasback Silage Wrap Recycling Program. Clean silage plastic, delivered in Plasback bags only, may be disposed of FREE at the Koonwarra and Foster transfer stations during normal operating hours. For further information visit www.plasback.com.au or contact Council.

Recycle clean farm chemical containers with *drumMUSTER*

South Gippsland Shire Council has established FREE *drumMUSTER* collection centres at all transfer stations. Farmers with less than 20 drums can dispose of them at any time without prior notice. To dispose of more than 20 drums at a time, farmers will need to make a booking by contacting Council on (03) 5662 9200.

To be accepted, all drums must:

- ✓ carry the *drumMUSTER* logo;
- ✓ be clean, dry and free of chemical residue (dirt, rust and dye stains are acceptable); and
- ✓ have lids removed.

Farm oil recycling

Oil generated from farming activities may be deposited free of charge at Koonwarra or Korumburra transfer stations. Only 1 x 200 litre drum is allowed per visit.
