

Capital works drop-in session

Council is giving the community an opportunity to discuss an important infrastructure project at a resident drop-in session in Leongatha next week.

The drop-in session gives residents a chance to speak directly with Council engineering staff.

Engineering Coordinator, Paul Challis, said the drop-in session allows people to raise questions and any concerns about the detailed designs that have been drafted.

"The session allows Council engineers to consider the feedback presented and clarify any uncertainty about the projects during this community engagement opportunity," he explained.

The drop-in session will focus on a reconstruction of A'Beckett Street, between Long Street and Hassett Street.

Residents will be able to view large scale plans of the proposed works, while having detailed conversations with Council staff.

The drop-in session will be held on Tuesday 13 October in Meeting Room 1 (Council Chamber), Michael Place, Leongatha. Residents are welcome to attend anytime between 4.30 - 6.00pm.
