### Name the Hub

Suggestions for an official name for the 'Korumburra Hub' are now being accepted.

All significant buildings, roads, localities and features in Victoria must have an official name to help ensure public safety and to help with navigation.

Selected names are registered with Geographic Names Victoria and this information is passed on to emergency services. South Gippsland Shire Council is commencing the process early so that the community can become familiar with the adopted name and because naming approvals can take time.

Names can be related to Korumburra, it's people and culture, Traditional Owner heritage, local flora and fauna, Australian War contribution or it could just be something simple like the current temporary name.

Submitted names will be evaluated against naming criteria and will then be shortlisted with assistance from the Korumburra Round Table. After the shortlist has been developed, the names will go out for a public vote to decide the final name that will be officially adopted.

The new hub will be home to the library, Milpara Community House and other community groups.





Once all votes are in they will be counted and the name with the majority of votes will become the official name of the of the Community Hub, subject to South Gippsland Shire Council approval. A report will then be forwarded to Geographic Names Victoria for final consideration and approval of the new name.
